
FSHG Scheduling Reminder:



- When scheduling Fluoroscopy-Hysterosalpingogram (that was a mouthful! 😊), also known as FSHG exams, you do NOT have to reference the Radiologist Physician List by Modality job aid, or the radiologist schedule in Lightning Bolt.
