## FSHG Scheduling Reminder:



• When scheduling Fluoroscopy-Hysterosalpingogram (that was a mouthful! 😔 ), also known as FSHG exams, you do NOT have to reference the Radiologist Physician List by Modality job aid, or the radiologist schedule in Lightening Bolt.



- This exam is ONLY performed by male radiologists.
- This exam type must be forced onto the schedule, be sure to read any blocks on the timeslot <u>before</u> forcing the exam.
