Diagnostic Mammogram Scheduling - DC/19th Street:

WE GOT THIS!



- Moving forward, for DC/19th Street only, schedule the Diagnostic Mammogram WITHOUT the Breast Ultrasound.
- If a Breast Ultrasound is needed, it will be added by the Center when the patient arrives.
- This change applies exclusively to the DC/19th Street Center.
- For Breast Ultrasound and urgent Diagnostic Mammogram requests, continue to follow the existing process by emailing the contacts listed in the Symptomatic Patient Needs Sooner Appointment Job Aid.
- At all other centers (Fairfax, Sterling, Chevy Chase, Park Potomac, Germantown), continue to schedule both the Diagnostic Mammogram and Breast Ultrasound together.
